- My ability to use public transport to travel to the campus.
- My ability to walk to the campus if the journey is under 3 miles.

To meet the funding body's requirements, could you please provide a statement on the attached DSA medical evidence form. This should include:

- My diagnosis in section 3.2.
- The functional impact of my condition on my ability to walk or use public transport to travel to my campus. This information can be added to section 3.1 of the form and will help ensure that my application is processed.
- A tick in the 'Yes' box on page 3 to confirm that my condition is classed as long term.
- Your details added to section 2 of the form.
